



### PROOF OF WOUND HEALING



Data of clinical observations (n=100) indicated a noticeable change of phases of wound healing. Inflammatory phase is decreased and the proliferative phase is increased (granulation and epithelialization) after 10 days of Cutimed® Sorbact® Hydroactive treatment.
